CHAPTER 3 — THE LAST-DAYS CHURCH AND THE OUTPOURING

Leader's Teaching Notes (Condensed)

Key Scripture — Acts 2:16 (KJV)

“But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel.”

Big Idea for Leaders

The last-days Church must be **Spirit-filled, bold, discerning, and mission-focused**.

Teaching Points

- 1. Born in Power** The Church began with a supernatural outpouring. Leaders must emphasize that Pentecost is the model, not the exception.
- 2. Boldness** Highlight how the Spirit transforms fear into courage. Encourage leaders to model boldness in their own walk.
- 3. Discernment** Teach believers how to recognize truth, reject deception, and follow the Spirit's guidance.
- 4. Mission** Remind the group that the last-days Church is called to advance the Kingdom with urgency and compassion.

GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Use these questions to guide your group:

1. Why is boldness essential for the last-days Church?
2. How does the Holy Spirit help us discern truth in confusing times?
3. What does it mean to be a Spirit-filled witness today?
4. Where do you see the outpouring happening in your own life or church?

Encourage open conversation, Scripture sharing, and testimonies.

MINISTRY MOMENT (Leader Prompt)

After discussion, lead the group into a short ministry moment:

- Invite the Holy Spirit to bring fresh boldness.
- Pray for clarity and discernment.
- Encourage believers to surrender areas where fear has held them back.
- Allow time for personal reflection and quiet prayer.

Leaders should remain sensitive to the Spirit's direction.

PRAYER FOR THE GROUP

Prayer: “Holy Spirit, fill us with Your power for these last days. Give us boldness to witness, discernment to walk in truth, and strength to fulfill Your mission. Prepare our hearts for Your outpouring and unite us in Your purpose. Amen.”
