HOW TO USE THIS LEADER'S GUIDE

1. Follow the Session Structure

Each session includes teaching, discussion, ministry, and prayer.

2. Prepare Spiritually Before Leading

Spend time in prayer and Scripture before each meeting.

3. Create a Revival Atmosphere

Encourage worship, openness, and expectation.

4. Facilitate, Don't Dominate

Guide the group, but let the Holy Spirit lead.

5. Protect Unity and Purity

Revival thrives in a clean, unified environment.

6. Expect God to Move

Revival is supernatural — stay sensitive to the Spirit.

Key Scripture

Psalm 85:6

Leader's Teaching Notes

- Revival begins with hunger
- Revival is God-initiated
- Spiritual decline requires spiritual awakening
- Revival is not emotional hype
- God awakens those who seek Him

Session Flow

1. Opening prayer
2. Read Psalm 85:6
3. Teach the session summary
4. Lead discussion
5. Ministry moment
6. Closing prayer

- What does spiritual hunger look like?
- What areas of life feel spiritually dry?
